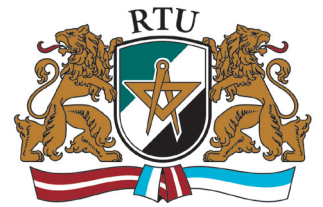

Prospective authors should submit one electronic copy of an Extended Abstract - Digest (full 2 pages) of the paper, including the summary, introduction, body text (experiments and discussions), conclusions, and a list of references. Submissions should include the name(s) affiliation(s) of the author(s) and number of the topic. Please submit abstracts by e-mail to ia2010@rtu.lv till **April 20, 2010** including name or number of the topic.
